



Family Travel Readiness Checklist

PREPARE EACH HOUSEHOLD FOR DEPARTURE

Travel Documents

- Government-issued identification reviewed.
- Passport requirements reviewed when applicable.
- Names on reservations match required identification.
- Minor-travel documentation reviewed when applicable.
- Travel confirmations saved or printed.

Health, Accessibility & Personal Preparation

- Necessary medications packed in carry-on luggage.
- Accessibility arrangements confirmed where applicable.
- Dietary requests communicated through the appropriate travel process.
- Emergency contacts saved.
- Travel insurance/protection documents available if purchased.

Transportation & Arrival

- Transportation to departure city confirmed.
- Pre-cruise/pre-trip hotel confirmed if needed.
- Parking or airport transfers confirmed.
- Arrival time allows adequate buffer before required check-in.

Reunion Preparation

- Family schedule saved.
- Coordinator contact information saved.
- Family shirts/keepsakes packed.
- Recognition or history materials packed if assigned.
- Household knows which activities are family-wide and which are optional.

Travel requirements can change. Families should verify current requirements with the authorized travel provider and relevant government or transportation sources before departure.
