



Post-Reunion Continuity Guide

KEEP THE FAMILY CONNECTED AFTER EVERYONE RETURNS HOME

Within 7 Days

- Thank volunteers and family coordinators.
- Share a central link or method for exchanging photographs.
- Send any promised follow-up information.
- Record important decisions before they are forgotten.

Within 30 Days

- Collect family feedback.
- Organize photographs and videos.
- Save family-history materials gathered during the reunion.
- Document what worked and what should change next time.
- Confirm who will maintain the family contact list.

Within 3-6 Months

- Share a reunion recap.
- Continue family history interviews if desired.
- Recognize new milestones or achievements.
- Begin preliminary discussion about the next gathering.
